In addition to the subjects covered on a standard Emergency First Aid at Work course, it also includes paediatric first aid training relevant to a school environment. Areas covered:

The role of the first aider - Importance of preventing cross infection - The need for - recording incidents and actions - Use of available equipment - Assessing the situation & act safely in an emergency - Administer Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation - Safe use of an Automated External Defibrillator - Administer first aid to a casualty who is unconscious - choking - wounded or bleeding - suffering from shock - Provide appropriate first aid for Minor Injuries (small cuts, grazes, bruises, minor burns, scalds & small splinters) - Administer Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation to a child - Recognition and management of Asthma - Recognition and management of Anaphylaxis - Administer first aid to a child who is unconscious (including seizures) or choking.
